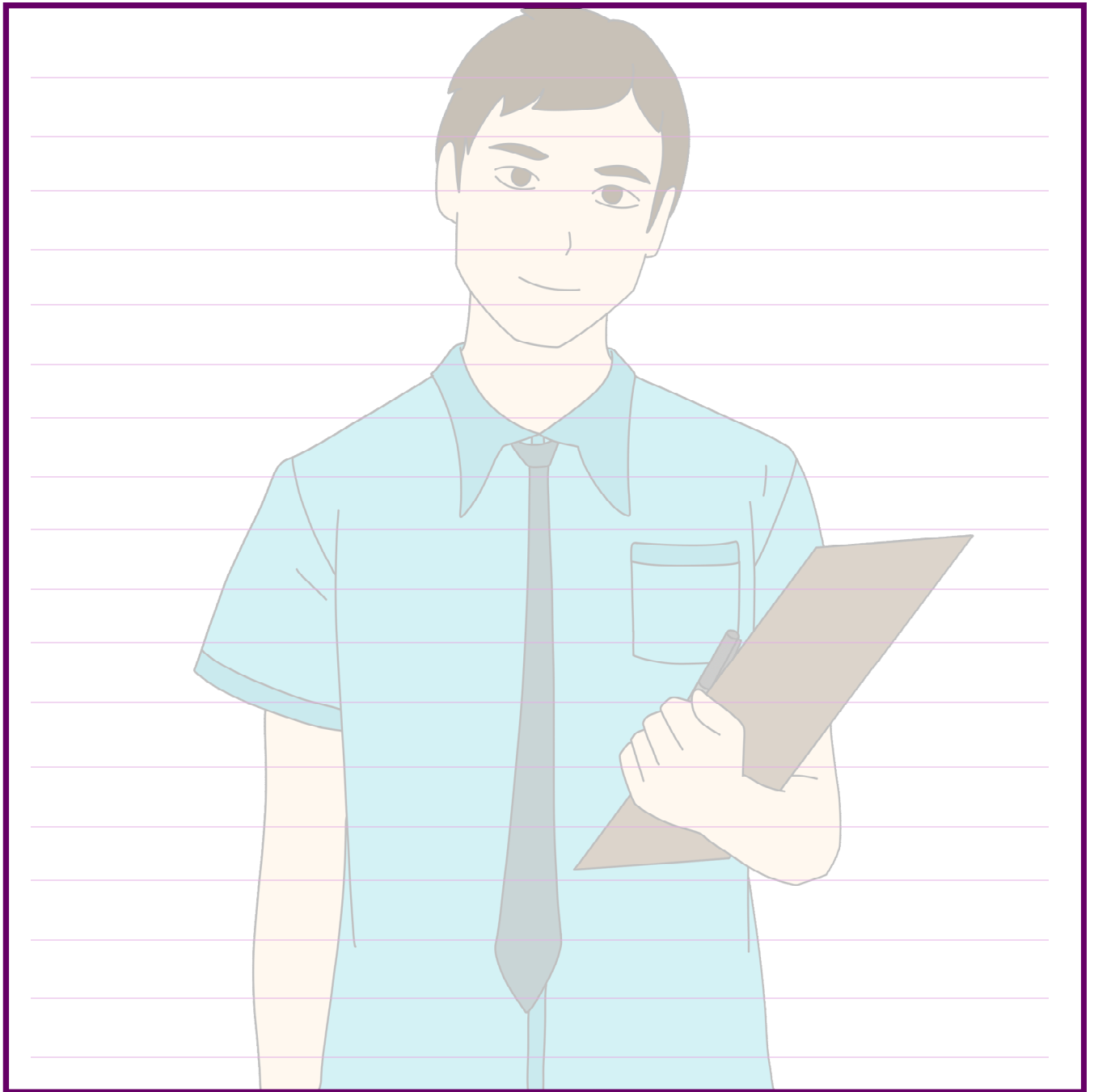

Imagine...

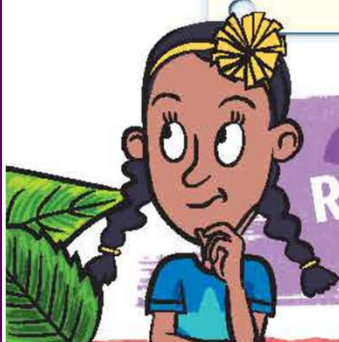
Five friends are hiking in the woods. They are having a great time. Suddenly, they realize they are lost, hungry, and it will be dark soon.
