About the PAT series

Our modular system for testing of battery materials

The novel PAT (Parallel Test) family is built around the PAT-Core, the single-use assembly comprising anode, cathode, reference electrode and separator. This PAT-Core is hermetically sealed inside the PAT-Cell, protecting the sensitive battery components against the outside atmosphere. Different versions serve different battery chemistries including aprotic and aqueous systems, with the focus on Li-ion batteries. Specialized PAT-Cells are equipped with sensors for the in-situ measurement of additional variables such as temperature and gas pressure.

The PAT family is completed by a variety of docking and test stations. The simplest docking station, the PAT-Stand-1, is for connection of a single PAT-Cell to an existing potentiostat. The PAT-Chamber is a temperature-controlled, 16-channel docking station for connection to an existing multi-channel potentiostat. Finally, the most advanced PAT test station, the PAT-Tester-i-16, integrates a 16-channel docking station, a fully featured multi-channel battery tester, and a temperature chamber into one single instrument.

Why PAT?

With the ring reference built into the PAT-Core, the halfcell voltages can be monitored throughout the whole battery life.

PAT-Core

Enabling ageing studies and impedance spectra of unmatched quality

The PAT-Core is the essential part of the PAT-cell holding in place and precisely aligning the electrodes being tested. The well-defined geometry of the PAT-Core enables high-quality two- and three-electrode tests of Li-ion and other battery materials as well as supercapacitors.


The PAT-Core comprises three components. The first part is a highly customizable insulation sleeve made of polypropylene with a built-in separator and ring-shaped reference electrode. Different reference materials like sodium or magnesium and various separator materials such as glass fiber or microporous polyolefine are available.

The single-use concept lowers lead times in the lab and minimizes the risk of cross-contamination. The insulation sleeve is pre-assembled under a protective atmosphere at the EL-CELL® factory to ensure consistent quality for reproducible battery tests.

The upper and lower plungers complete the PAT-Core. Plungers are made of aluminum, copper, or stainless steel, functioning as current collectors. This enables battery researchers to work exclusively with battery-grade materials. Aluminum and copper plungers are single-use parts, while the stainless steel plungers can be reused.

The PAT-Cell is the test cell for reproducible testing of battery materials with high throughput. The PAT-Cell has no sockets for direct cable connections. The pre-assembled PAT sleeve greatly facilitates and speeds up the building of test cells. Due to the single-use concept, there is no need for cleaning or drying cell components.




The new test cell for aqueous electrolytes

The PAT-Cell-Aqu is the newest PAT-series test cell dedicated to the characterization of aqueous batteries. Functionally, the PAT-Core-Aqu comprises three components: the insulation sleeve with a built-in separator and reference ring, and two 18 mm diameter current collectors, each contacted by a feed wire. By default, current collectors and feed wires are made of pure gold. The feed wires are held in place by plungers made of PEEK polymer.

As a result, the PAT-Cell-Aqu does withstands most aqueous electrolytes such as sulfuric acid (up to 50% concentration) or potassium hydroxide solution. Other metals such as Pt and Ni are optionally available as current collectors, and may be easily replaced by the user. While most appropriate for aqueous electrochemistry, the PAT-Cell-Aqu can also be used for aprotic systems beyond Li-ion with special demands on corrosion stability.

PAT-Cell-Press

Pressure test cell for the PAT series

The PAT-Cell-Press is the PAT-Cell with an integrated pressure sensor and a sample port for drawing gas samples from the cell's head space. The PAT-Cell-Press can be operated in three different ways: either as part of the PAT-Press package, or plugged into the PAT-Chamber-16, or plugged into the PAT-Tester-i-16. The advanced design of the PAT-Cell-Press includes a laser-welded pressure sensor and glass-to-metal seals for the electrode feedthroughs.

The number of non-permanent seals is reduced to its minimum: a single PE seal between cell lid and base and a ferrule when the cell is ordered with the optional gas sample port. In order to ensure best testing results, every PAT-Cell-Press has been tested to be free of helium leaks before delivery.




The PAT-Cell-Press-Aqu is the aqueous version of the PAT-Cell-Press. The special design can withstand all common aqueous electrolytes such as sulfuric acid and potassium hydroxide solution. All current collectors and feed wires are made of gold. Other metals such as Pt and Ni are available as an option.

Due to its excellent corrosion resistance, the PAT-Cell-Press-Aqu can also be used for aprotic systems beyond Li-ion.

The PAT-Cell-Press-Aqu is our specialized pressure test cell for aqueous electrolytes and non-lithium battery systems.

Specialized PAT-Core components

To meet the challenges of battery tests at elevated temperatures up to 200°C, we offer a HT version of the insulation sleeve. This reusable HT-sleeve is made of PEEK (rather then PP) and is especially useful for the investigation of solid state (ceramic) electrolyte membranes. Just like the standard sleeve, the HT-sleeve can be equipped with different reference materials such as lithium, sodium or magnesium. The standard current collectors (plungers) complete the PAT-Core. Available plunger materials are aluminum and copper (for single use), or stainless steel 316L (for reuse).

The PAT-Heater-4 is a heated docking station connecting up to 4 PAT-Cell-HT to any potentiostat or battery tester. The working temperature is adjustable from 10°C above ambient temperature up to 200°C. The PAT-Heater-4 saves wiring effort, because it is not

necessary to renew the connection between cell and potentiostat for every battery test. However the easy-to-access banana sockets at the side of the docking station allow for flexible wiring.

The PAT-Heater-4 is the temperature controlled docking station for parallel electrochemical tests with high temperatures up to 200°C.

The PAT-Stand-1 is a docking station, that runs a single PAT-series test cell e.g. PAT-Cell-Press. It can be connected directly to a common potentiostat or battery tester using 4 mm banana sockets or a hardwired Sub-D socket. Therefore, the PAT-Stand-1 saves wiring effort, because it is not necessary to renew the connection of cell and potentiostat for every battery test.

The PAT-Stand-1 fits nicely into a normal climate chamber and is small enough to be placed inside a glovebox. This enables you to perform whole battery tests inside the glovebox.

The PAT-Stand-1 saves space in the lab and allows immediate functional testing of all PAT-series test cells.


The PAT-Stand-16 is the docking station for up to 16 PAT-Cells in a 4 x 4 matrix. It has a built-in data logger recording full- and half-cell voltages, cell current, tray temperature and time. The PAT-Stand-16 can be operated with a usual multi-channel potentiostat (like the Biologic MPG-2 or VMP300) or battery tester (like the Maccor 4000).

This way, the PAT-Stand-16 saves wiring effort, because it is not necessary to renew the connection of cell and potentiostat for every battery test. Furthermore, it fits nicely into a normal climate chamber (such as Binder KB53), which saves space in the lab.

All of these features make the PAT-Stand-16 the optimum solution for high throughput testing when using an external battery tester.

The integrated Peltier device enables you to test at the exact temperature you need, without using an external heat chamber. The PAT-Chamber-16 is our first high-throughput docking station that is capable of utilizing both the PAT-Cell and the PAT-Cell-Press for in-situ pressure monitoring of up to 16 test cells at the same time.

Just like the PAT-Stand-16, the PAT-Chamber-16 comes with a built-in data logger recording full- and half-cell voltages, cell current, time, global temperature and individual cell pressure.

The PAT-Chamber-16 can be left connected permanently to all of today's multi-channel potentiostats or battery testers. This enables you to save a lot of wiring effort, because it is not necessary to renew the connection between cell and potentiostat for every battery test.

Such modular and distributed set-ups are flexible, but have severe drawbacks such as a large foot print, an extensive cable harness, unconsolidated data management, and susceptibility to experimental mistakes.

This can be the past! The new PAT-Tester-i-16 integrates all functions of a 16-channels battery tester, a PAT docking station, and a temperature-controlled test chamber into one single instrument. The world-wide patented wireless connection between test cell and potentiostat saves space in your lab and eliminates any wiring effort. Plug the PAT-Tester into the main power and get full remote access from any host PC on a network!


The internal impedance analyzer is capable of simultaneously recording both half-cell impedances. The intuitive, easy to use, yet powerful experiment builder enables starters in battery research to setup all common tests such as CCCV cycling, voltammetry and impedance measurements. A powerful script language allows experienced scientists to set up almost any kind of battery tests. All test channels feature a switch-matrix for software-controlled switching between half- and full-cell measurements without reconnecting any cables. Most advanced graphing capabilities allow users to review and compare data of running experiments with any experiment ever stored to the database.



Electrochemical Dilatometer

Watch your electrodes breathing

Our new electrochemical dilatometer is available in two versions, the ECD-3 and the ECD-3-nano. The two instruments mainly differ in the resolution and drift stability of the displacement sensor system that is attached to the electrochemical cell. The electrochemical cell is identical for both versions.



Working principle

The ECD-3 and ECD-3-nano electrochemical dilatometer measure the thickness change of a working electrode during the electrochemical cycle. The heart of the dilatometer is an electrochemical cell hermetically sealed against ambient atmosphere.





The working electrode WE and the counter electrode CE are separated by a stiff glass frit soaked with electrolyte. The upper WE is sealed by means of a flexible metal membrane, through which any charge-induced thickness change is transmitted towards the sensor/load unit attached on top. The fixation of the glass frit ensures that only the thickness change of the working electrode is being detected, without interference from the CE. Optionally, a reference electrode REF can be placed at the edge of the frit close to the working electrode.

Options

Various add-ons are available for special testing requirements, such as for using aqueous electrolytes, for using single grains or crystals instead of bound electrode films and for measuring the thickness change of the whole battery stack instead of only the working electrode.

Processes on your working electrode will become directly visible

The ECC-Opto-Std test cell serves to monitor the optical properties of an electrode material in the course of electrochemical charging. It is dedicated to the inspection of electrodes by optical methods such as light microscopy or Raman spectroscopy working in the reflection mode. Basically, the respective instrument looks through a transparent window onto the backside of the working electrode.

The ECC-Opto-Std is easily adapted by optional special kits (e.g. for XRD) to the respective battery system and optical instrumentation used

As a standard, the ECC-Opto-Std is equipped with a borosilicate glass window. Depending on your testing purposes, different optional window kits are available.

Cell holder for ECC-Opto-Std

The cell holder is designed for the use of the ECC-Opto-Std in light microscopes. It fits nicely on sample stages of most manufacturers (e.g. Thermofisher or Renishaw) utilizing standard microscope slides $(75 \times 26 \text{ mm}, ISO 8037-1)$.

Optional Window Kits

Every special kit (e.g. ECC-OPTO beryllium window kit) includes one or more windows of specific material (e.g. beryllium) and one modified lid with inspection hole of specific shape and size (e.g. 10 mm inspection hole, min. viewing angle 8°). Further window materials like magnesium oxide, silicon dioxide, silicon nitride or PET (Mylar®) are available on request. Additionally, customization of the cell lids is possible.





ECC-Opto-Std-Aqu

The ECC-Opto-Std-Aqu optical test cell is a variant of our popular ECC-Opto-Std, specialized for use with aqueous electrochemistry. Like the ECC-Opto-Std it is a 2- and 3-electrode test cell for optical characterization in the reflective mode with face-to-face arrangement of electrodes. Typical uses include optical and confocal Raman microscopy. Materials in direct media contact are made of gold, PEEK, and EPDM.

ECC-Opto-SBS

With the ECC-Opto-SBS, the electrode can be observed in-situ in the reflective mode — just as with the ECC-Opto-Std. The special thing about the ECC-Opto-SBS is the side-by-side ("face up") arrangement of the electrodes which differs from the conventional sandwich ("face-to-face") arrangement of the ECC-Opto-Std.



Special purpose test cells

ECC-Air

The ECC-Air is a member of the ECC series dedicated to the electrochemical characterization of gas diffusion electrodes in aprotic electrolytes, e.g. for lithium-air batteries.

Basically, the upper diffusion type electrode is contacted by and "breathes" through the perforated stainless steel current collector on top. Two ports in the cell lid serve to connect the inside cell volume to the external gas supply and outlet. The design includes a reference electrode.



ECC-Air-Ni

In contrast to the standard ECC-Air test cell, the current collectors of the ECC-Air-Ni are made of nickel instead of stainless steel. This way, the test cell is stable against corrosion in alkaline aqueous electrolytes.

The ECC-Air-Ni can be used with a reference electrode, which is located at the separator edge.



ECC-DEMS

This test cell is dedicated to the in-situ gas analysis in aprotic Li-air and conventional Li-ion systems. The cell features a current collector with a spiral-shaped flow-field that is to be constantly purged with a gentle stream of inert gas. The flow-field is located at the bottom of the cell base. The composition of the outgoing gas can be analyzed by e.g. mass spectrometry. The ECC-DEMS cell provides almost perfect plug-flow of the purge gas, which is essential for quantitative time-resolved analysis.



ECC-Press-Air-DL

The ECC-Press-Air-DL test cell is dedicated to the characterization of gas diffusion electrodes in aprotic electrolytes, in particular for lithium-air batteries. The attached pressure sensor serves to monitor the inside pressure in either a flow-through or in a dead-end pressurized set-up.

The provided low-dead-volume sampling port/valve serves to draw gas samples from the cell's headspace. The cell hardware can be used with or without a reference electrode. The ECC-Press-Air-DL comes with a controller box for easy interfacing with an external potentiostat.

EL-Cut

High precision cutting pliers eliminate torn and chipped electrode edges.

The proper cutting of the electrodes is often an neglected factor in battery testing. Torn and chipped electrode edges — although invisible to the bare eye — inevitably cause current inhomogeneity and are thus likely to affect experimental results. Life cycle and impedance results are especially vulnerable to such artifacts. Electrodes being cut (fine blanked) by the EL-Cut are produced in tools with a few microns of cutting clearance. The fine blanking process results in electrodes having clean cutting surfaces without torn or chipped edges and being almost perfectly flat.

ECC-RefLoad

Tool for loading reference materials such as lithium metal into ECC-Opto-Std, ECC-Opto-SBS, and ECC-Agu test cells.

The device is basically a small tube (cannula) containing with a knock-out pin inside. A tiny piece of lithium metal is first picked up by pressing the cannula onto a piece of lithium foil. The cannula is then inserted into the bore of the Ref sleeve, and the lithium inside the cannula is extruded into the Ref bore by pushing the knock-out pin.
