- Testing and Validation: Verify DSP blocks against MATLAB and Simulink models and validate hardware on platforms such as Xilinx Zynq Ultrascale and Microchip PolarFire.
- Encoder/Decoder Deployment: Deploy and optimize encoding and decoding schemes (e.g., RS, Turbo, LDPC, BCH) and generate corresponding IP cores.
- Hardware Optimization: Optimize FPGA designs for resource utilization, latency reduction, and robust operation in aerospace environments.
- Advanced Algorithm Development: Implement communication algorithms (e.g., QPSK, CP, channel estimation) and real-time data exchange techniques (e.g., DMA, EDMA) for SDR platforms.
- Documentation and Support: Prepare technical documentation and provide support for ongoing production and testing of flight hardware.
