# OUR NEW CAMPUS

Welcome to our world-class campus in Pipera!

CSB's state-of-the-art campus allows our students the opportunities to explore their passions and invest in their futures.

Our purpose-built Primary and Secondary buildings provide the space and the technology to encourage growth and development in students of all ages.

CSB students enjoy specifically designed rooms for Art, Music, and Computer Science, classrooms that contain the most up-to-date technology available, and outdoor learning spaces that strengthen their connection to the natural world.

As we continue to evolve as a school community, our campus will develop with us. Our plans for future development include spaces for Design & Technology, Theatre, Dance, Athletics and Sport, Swimming, and so much more. This investment and planning will ensure that CSB students have both access and support when challenging themselves and exploring their potential.



## CURRICULUM

The British curriculum prides itself on nurturing open-minded, creative, and thoughtful individuals.

At CSB we provide a high-quality education and develop well-rounded individuals, nurturing the interests and talents of each student. Creating independent thinkers who are resilient and adaptable, have good manners, are able to cope with life's twists and turns, and have the skills necessary to take their thinking to the next level. It is our belief that rigorous academic application combined with the care and support of dedicated staff creates an optimum learning environment for the next generation of leaders.

In the Early Years Foundation Stage (Nursery and Reception), our students are encouraged to cultivate imagination, acquire the confidence to learn and explore, achieve resilience and independence, and to develop a deep sense of curiosity. Upon arriving in the EYFS, students begin their studies in Maths, English, Science, mother-tongue classes (Romanian, Turkish, Arabic, and Chinese), PE, and Drama, Music, and Art.

As students advance into Key Stages 1 through 3, they continue these core subjects and are introduced

to ICT, History, Geography, Modern Foreign Languages, all while deepening their independence, resilience, and personal commitment through extensive PSCHEE classes. This in-depth study prepares our students for success on both external exams and in Key Stages 4 and 5.

To prepare students for university, CSB provides support in the core subjects, and a full complement of CAIE courses from IGCSE to A Level. Year 13 students are also provided a preparatory IELTS class to ensure that they are university ready.

Over the course of a student's time here at CSB, our specialised Maths and English teachers provide intensive classes for EAL students as they transition into our school.











## PASTORAL CARE

At CSB, we take a whole-child approach to education.

Our experience tells us that academic performance improves when a child's emotional, moral, and spiritual needs are met. Through an in-depth PSCHEE programme, our students explore ways to develop their social skills, deal with stress, understand the complexity of interpersonal relationships, and grow into fine young adults.

As students cultivate these abilities, our active and proactive Heads of Year lend support and guidance to all pupils and liaise between students,

parents, and the Schools Leadership Team. These trained staff provide input and care that give confidence to students as they progress through their academics lives here at CSB.

CSB has a House System that provides opportunities for students to develop all aspects of their growth and learning: personality, creativity, knowledge, and and leadership skills. The system promotes values of fair play, teamwork, citizenship, mutual responsibility, self-discipline,

initiative, perseverance, and resilience. The CSB Form Tutoring system has many purposes; we try to foster our students' personal and social growth, so that they develop a sense of individual responsibility and an awareness of health-related issues. We also supervise their academic progress and encourage them to develop sound habits of work and study. Our aim is to graduate competent, emotionally aware, and empathetic young leaders.

## EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Young people need experiences outside the classroom to become committed, responsible, and fulfilled citizens of the world. Extra-curricular activities enrich the experience of pupils at CSB. We believe that making opportunities available in such areas as Music, Drama, Sport, and the Humanities reinforces the academic advancement of our pupils while contributing to their social, emotional, spiritual, and cultural development.

Our Student Union offers an important opportunity for our school to give back to the local community and to reinforce democratic principles with student representative elections.

Students in Years 10-13 can also participate in the Duke of Edinburgh bronze, silver and gold awards. This International Award gives students an edge when applying for university admissions as they have real life experience to show that they are energetic, selfdisciplined, can work in a team,

and have a commitment to the community.

We aim to give all pupils the opportunity to participate in their choice of extra-curricular activities in order to develop their skills in various areas. The activities on offer include: Modern Languages, Archery, Football, Basketball, Art, Music, Chess, Karate, Debate, and Dance. Our Secondary pupils also take full responsibility for running the Cambridge School newspaper. Volunteers write, edit, and organise the running of the paper on a monthly basis.









## COMMUNITY
