Offline learning activities

- 1. Linking to the chat session on relationships. Show your child a recipe to make a cake and discuss what is put inside. Talk about what might happen if we left any of the ingredients out or if we didn't follow it correctly. Ask your child to create a recipe for a happy relationship. What things do we need to be a good friend? Explain that relationships are a bit like cakes we need to put in lots of different ingredients to make them the best they can be. It would be lovely to see any these marvellous happy recipes, so please send them in to your teacher if you can.
- 2. Following on from all the healthy eating activities we have been doing, we would like your child to make a healthy salad this week. We would like them to have a go at chopping, slicing and grating the vegetables themselves. This is an important skill for the children to learn but please ensure they have adult supervision at all times. We would love to see any photos of the salads.
- 3. Can you create your own rocket ship together to go to the stars? You could make this from old boxes, plastic containers and scrap materials. Cutting, creating, designing, imagining and inventing are all great learning opportunities. Where will your rocket ship travel? Will there be a count down... 5, 4, 3, 2, 1, blast off? We would love to see pictures of your rocket ships!
