


WORDS FOR READING AND WRITING

Here is a selection of words for common objects around the home that you could use for reading and writing activities this week...

We do these at the start of every phonics session Complete 1 or 2 per day



Move it

Write down different sounds on separate pieces of paper. Give them out to all members of your family. Play 'I like to move it — Madagascar' on YouTube. Children (and adults) dance around the room, stop the music throughout. when the music stops, tell someone what sound you have. Repeat and tell someone new

Spinning top spin

Write sounds on separate pieces of paper and put them around the room. Adult to say a word, child to try to hear the initial sound and move towards the correct sound placed around the room.

i.e. boat = b Hat = h

Simon says

Similar to normal 'simon says'. Adult to give instructions by segmenting the sounds. For example, 'Simon says can you r-u-n' or 'Simon says can you h-o-p'
Children to blend the sounds and complete the instruction.

(run, hop, jump, skip, swim, shake, lay, climb, sit, dig)

Beat the timer

Write out sounds or tricky words onto separate pieces of paper and lay them face down. Adult to set a timer on a phone/tablet etc. How many can your child turn over and read correctly before the timer runs out. Can your child beat their score later on in the week?








Write the word 'he' on a piece of paper. Draw around the word. What does the shape look like? Can you think of a sentence that has the tricky word 'he' in it?
