
Phonics Chutes

Collect bottles or containers and make a chute, like the one pictured below. You can use these to post sounds, words, sentences, tricky words or objects for your child to read, write or segment!



Dance mat!

Copy the dance mat below. You may need to use multiple pieces of paper, to make room for your child's hands and feet. Give your child one of these words (shop, shed, ship, chop, chip, chin) Can you child segment the sounds and use their hands and their feet to press on the right sounds.



Bottle top reading

Write these words onto separate pieces of paper. (milk, tent, clap, crab, step, desk)

Ask your child to put a bottle lid under each sound. Explain that these are the sound buttons.

Ask your child to read the word by pushing each button (bottle lid) and saying the sound and then blend the sounds together. If your child is finding it tricky, start segmenting slow and then go a little bit faster each time.

Pause or mute the video. Can your child recognise the tricky word before it plays!

Tricky word hunt Find a handful of books from around your home. These can be story books, information books or any other books around your home. Have a look through the books and see if you can find any tricky words. (Please look on next slide to find a list of tricky words.) You may need to help your child, so please ask them to look at a particular sentence and see if they can pick it out. When they have found a tricky word, can they write down which pones they have found.

Tricky word quiz

Can you have a go writing tricky words in a tricky word quiz.

First quickly recap all of the tricky words learnt so far in Phase 3.

(he, she, we, me, be, you, are, her, all, was, my and they)

Adult to call out one of the tricky words above and ask your child to write it.


You can either write them or use cut up letters to build the word.









Sorting words



<u>Challenge:</u> Can you write the words that you find!










You will find a larger version of this on the next page. Can you 'roll and read'?
