Offline learning activities

1. **Maths** -

Circle the ice lollies that match the number sentence.

$$8 = 2 + 2 + 2 + 2$$



Can you write the number sentence for the lollies you **did not** circle?

Is there another number sentence you could use to explain how many lollies are in each picture? Think about subtraction, multiplication or division.

2. **English** - When we write in the past tense, we add the suffix 'ed' to the end of the verb. For example, I **walked** to the park. Can you add 'ed' to the following words to show that they happened in the past?

Jump, climb, finish, play, fold, open.

Now can you write each word in a sentence?

3 **Art** - Joseph Wright 'of Derby was an artist who was famous for a technique known as Chiaroscuro, which means for light-dark, in art, is the use of strong contrast between light and dark. He was famous for using candlelight to illuminate his subjects in his paintings.

Look at this picture. What do you think is in the glass jar?



In the jar is a bird. How do you think the bird is feeling? Where do birds live? How do we see them? We would like you to make your very own binoculars to become bird watchers. They are going to be super snazzy and you are going to use your artistic skills to decorate them. Here is an example



To make your binoculars, you will need the following materials
Toilet rolls, glue, paint, variety of materials to use to stamp patterns - eg, sponge, corks, wooden shapes, end of a paintbrush. It will be great to see some of your designs!

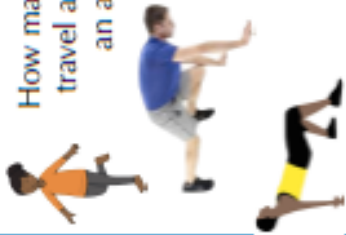
