# <u>CHAT</u>

# **PLAY**

### Online:

Allery Destroys

- Play a game of 'Who am I?'. There are some examples to use in the resource section below. Read out the 3 clues to your child and see if they can guess what minibeast you are. Can you think of anymore? Can your child have a go at thinking of some clues to ask you?

- Make your very own bug hotel



What you will need:

- o A large plastic bottle cut into two cylinders,
- o sticks,
- o pine cones,
- bark/soil/stones
- o anything else you can find bamboo with it's holes is great too!

What you need to do:



- 1. Cut the bottle down to size.
- 2. Arrange your materials. Check what materials you have and arrange by size and texture you could snap your sticks to make them a little smaller. Arrange any ine cones inside the bottle and put in any loose bark/soil/stones you may have collected

- 3. Decide on the insect hotel location and add twine for hanging
- 4. If you plan to hang your bug hotel, loop some garden twine round and then start layering your bug hotel. You could make one hotel for on the ground and one for hanging from a tree to see if would attract different minibeasts.

5. ake the insect hotel nice and cozy

6. Stuff it to make it nice and firm, so it doesn't get blown about!

#### **READ**


