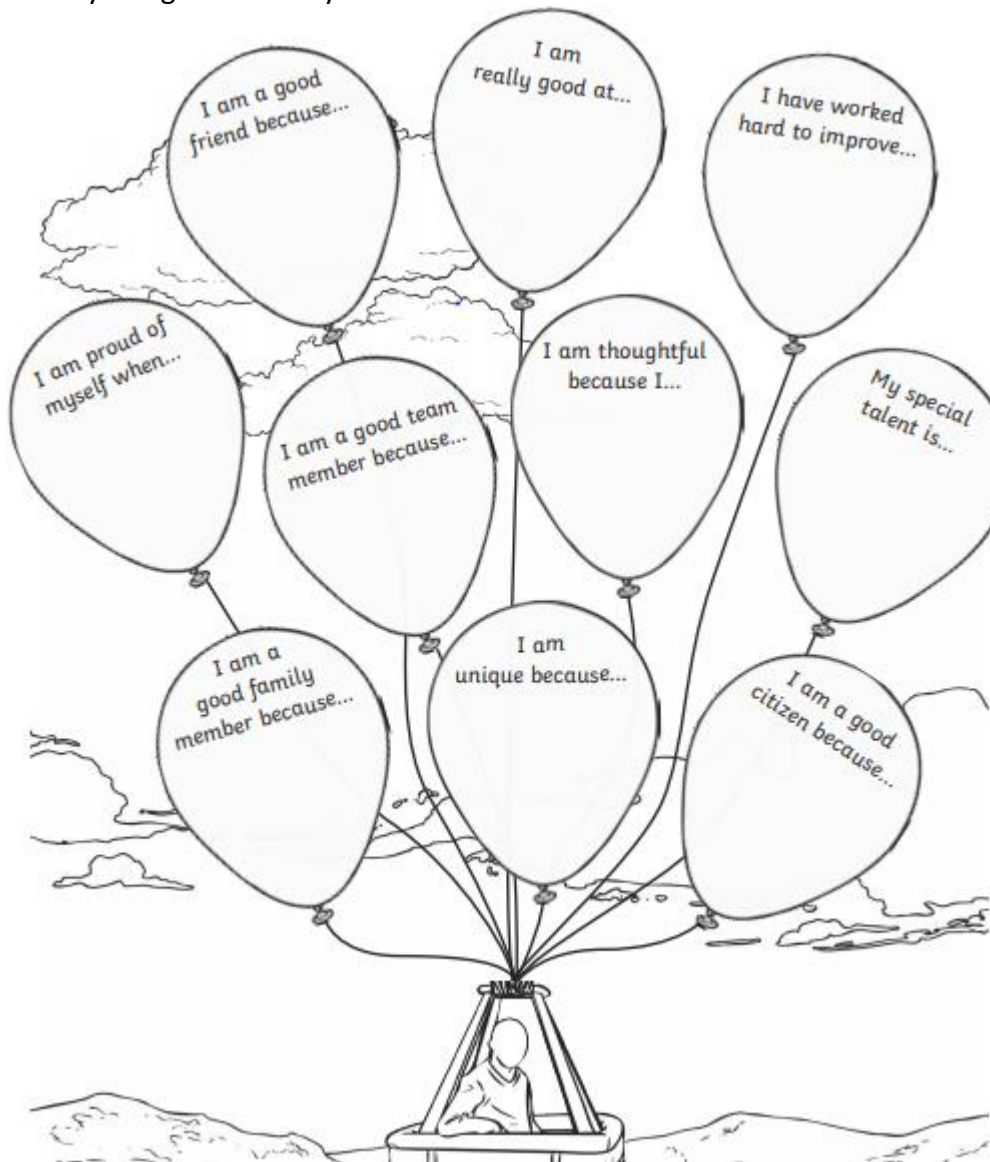


## Home Learning Year 4

These are the spellings you have been focusing on this term. Can you challenge yourself to try and spell all of the words correctly?

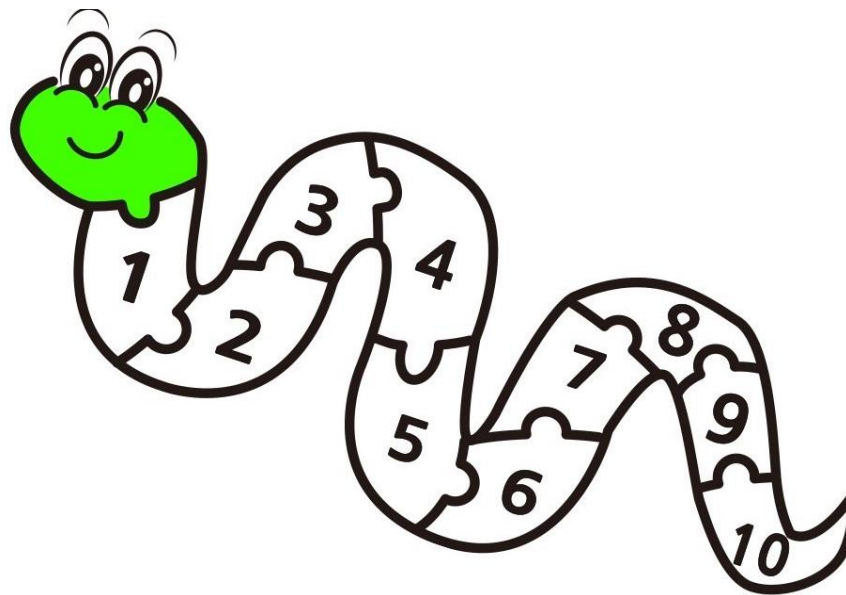
