Times tables



Year 3 is a crucial year for times tables learning. Children are expected to be secure with their 2,5 and 10x tables and will learn **multiplication facts** for the 3, 4 and 8 times tables in class throughout the year.

The expectation is that you know the answers immediately; don't forget, knowing a times table means also knowing the inverse (division ÷) fact.
