TAEKWONDO

Master Jeffries, the instructor of Fairlands Taekwondo, has just returned from Korea, where he attended a week's World Taekwondo Leaders Forum (the world headquarters invited 150 masters from 53 countries out of the 70 million worldwide Taekwondo practitioners to attend). This was a great opportunity to learn current Olympic Taekwondo techniques and train/meet with some of the most powerful people in Taekwondo to form international friendships.

Fairlands Taekwondo is part of Stevenage Taekwondo now and is the only Olympic Taekwondo group in North Herts. They have a couple of available spaces in the 3-6 year old Kicking Kids class and a few open spaces in the 7-14 Fairlands Taekwondo class, both held on a Saturday morning.
