I love reading stories out loud (and looking at the lovely pictures).

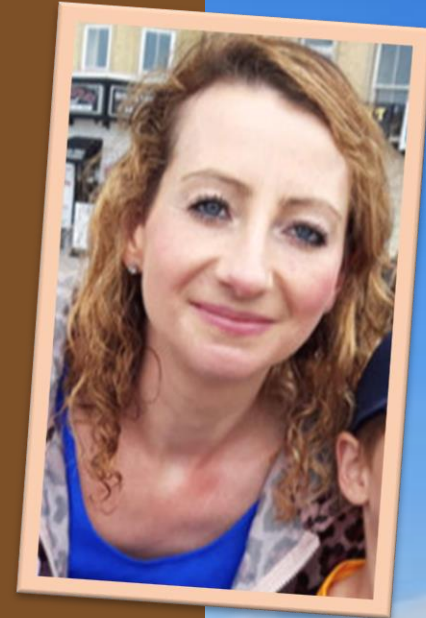
I love supporting pupils to be the best they can be with regards to their school work, skills, their friendships and their aspirations.
