Start and end of the day – Year 4

-  The statue gate is unlocked at 8:40 am by Miss Bridge
-  Children enter via their external classroom doors and start a learning activity straight away
-  Any urgent messages for teachers can be passed on via Miss Bridge at the gate
-  Children are encouraged to be increasingly independent – please encourage your child **to pass on messages to their class teacher if they feel able to**
-  The gate is locked at 8:50 am
-  Children arriving after 8.50am are late!
-  The statue gate will be unlocked before 3.15pm
-  Collect children from the external classroom doors
-  Year 4 children will only be released to adults named on the yellow sheets
