Pirate Day!

Pirate Day will be **Wednesday, 1st April**. All staff and children in the Foundation Stage are invited to dress up as a pirate for the day. Some ideas that you might want to use are:

- Tea towel/fabric/scarf as a pirates' head scarf
- Eye patch
- Face paint of skull and cross bones
- White shirt/ stripy top with large black belt
- Waist coat

Turn Your Teacher's into Pirates! Children will be challenged to alter photos of Miss Morgan and Mrs Yendell to create a pirate look!

Manning The Ship! Children will be challenged to follow a series of instructions to keep the 'Good Ship Staples' afloat!

A Pirate Sing-a-long! Children will sing a number of nautical songs and learn a few pirate sayings!
