ENGLISH LANGUAGE CLASS

The classes are for all adult speakers of languages other than English, who wish to improve their English skills. They cater for all – from complete beginners to advanced learners.

FRIDAY COFFEE MORNINGS

Parents/Carers are invited to come to the Community Room (upper building) on **Friday mornings** from **9.00am** for coffee and a chat. This is a great opportunity to get to know other parents and will also be attended by Sara Hassell, our Family Lives worker.

LOWER BUILDING GAMES LIBRARY

Toys and games are available to borrow from the **Games Library**, which is run on **Friday mornings** in the **Lower Hall** from **8.50 to 9.00am**.

This is a great opportunity to borrow games for your children to play at home and, in exactly the same way as you would borrow books from a library; you can change them as often as you like – AND IT'S FREE!
