Guidelines for Contributors

- a. Articles submitted should be original and must not have been submitted elsewhere for publication consideration while under review for this journal.
- b. Submission should be in Times New Roman (word document format), 12 font size and double line spacing and NOT more than 25 pages of A4 paper, including tables, charts, graphs, appendixes, and references. All tables must be numbered (e.g., Table 1. Table 2 etc.)
- c. IJMLPD currently accept only manuscript written in English Language.
- d. The abstract should NOT be more than 200 words with a maximum of five (5) keywords
- e. The first page of the manuscript should contain the following: Titles of the article, name(s), institutional affiliation(s) and email address(es)
- f. The text of the article should then begin on page 2 below the title to preserve anonymity in review.
- g. All papers must undergo a similarity index test and should not be more than 15%
- h. Citations throughout the work and references should strictly adhere to the most current version of the APA referencing style.
