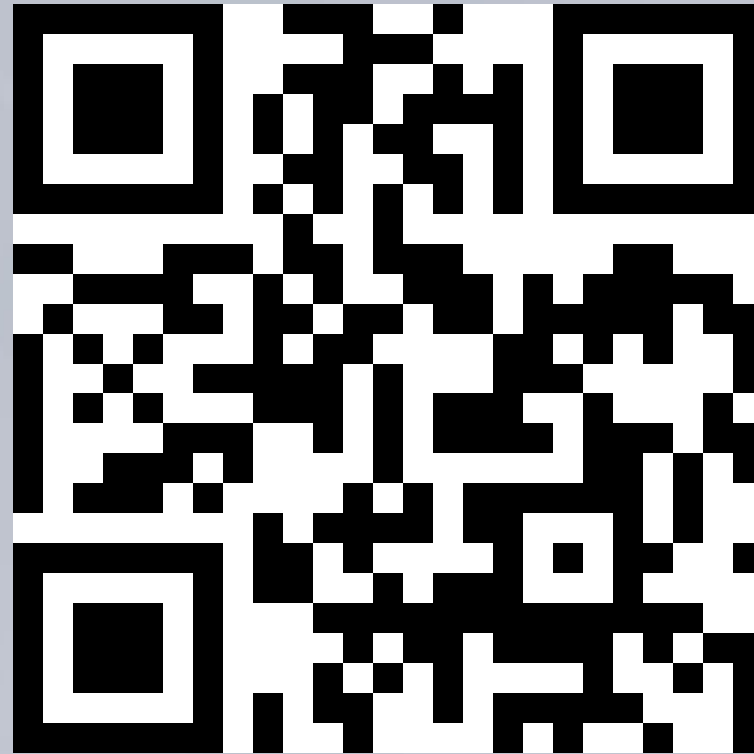

Written Exams (Total 5 exams)

- First 2 weeks of June
- Time frame:
4 hours - LI, LIA, L2A, Philo4 and Ma 5
5 hours – Art (preparation part and an exam)
3 hours – Other subjects
- Mark: The average of teacher's and external examiners' mark.
(If the difference is more than 2 grades, 3rd examiner will be used.)

Oral Exams (Total 3 exams)

- In June-July
- Two examiners – Teacher and external
- 20 minutes preparation
+
20 minutes examination
- One candidate might have two exams in one day.

Subject notes

Case 1: No written or no oral exams

$$\textit{Subject mark} = \frac{0,2 \times A + 0,3 \times B}{0,5}$$

Case 2: Only written exam

$$\textit{Subject mark} = \frac{0,2 \times A + 0,3 \times B + 0,35 \times W}{0,85}$$

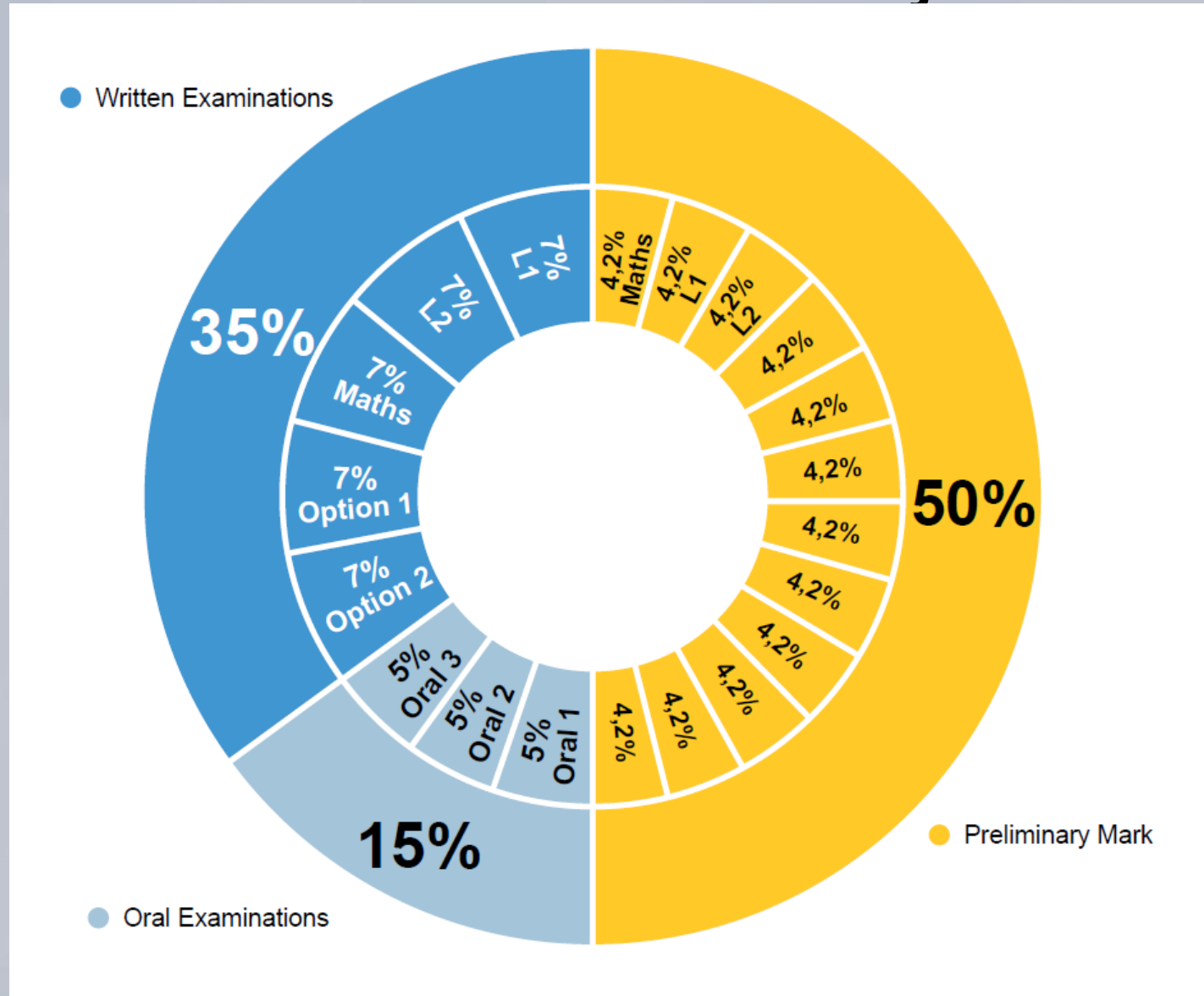
Case 3: Only oral exam

$$\textit{Subject mark} = \frac{0,2 \times A + 0,3 \times B + 0,15 \times O}{0,65}$$

Case 4: Both exams

$$\textit{Subject mark} = 0,2 \times A + 0,3 \times B + 0,35 \times W + 0,15 \times O$$

Options

If the option courses in History or Geography cannot be created in the working language of the pupil, (s)he can follow it in another working language.

This is on the condition that it is not the pupil's mother tongue and that a group is created.

Options

Options already begun in the 4th year (Latin, Economics and Language 4) can be continued only if sufficient numbers of pupils choose these options.

If an option course that is normally taught in mother tongue (Bio4, Chi4, Phy4 & Philo4) cannot be created in a particular language section, it will, if possible, be offered in one of the working languages.

Options

- Change of L2 can be requested.
- It won't change the working language (Geo & History)
- A level test is needed in June

Options

- If a student wants to start a new subject which (s)he hasn't studied before, a level test is needed to be done in June
- This can apply for example with subjects Economics, L4, Art or Music.

Procedure with the choices

- 1) After the submitting the online form, students will receive a confirmation form on paper which needs to be signed by the legal guardian
- 2) Management will create a timetable grid by the end of April. Then there is a possibility that students need to make the 2nd choices in the case of:
 - a) There are less than 5 students in the course
 - b) There are clashes in the timetable
- 3) Changes can be requested by a form on school's website in September. Positive answer is not guaranteed.

NOT good reasons to change or drop the subject

- I don't like the teacher
- I have hobbies at 16h00
- My friend is another class
- I don't like my timetable

Good reasons to change or drop the subject

- I have reconsidered my career path and after talking about it with my parents and the orientation team I have decided to change X to Y
- I think 35/36 lessons is too much for me

Changes in choices

- No changes in S6 after September
- Between S6 and S7 you can request to drop a subject.
- Only possible changes:
 - Maths 3 $\Leftrightarrow$ Maths 5
 - 4 period subject $\Leftrightarrow$ 2 period subject
