Requirements concerning the equipment of the competitor / glider

Competitors are required to arrive at the competition by the date specified above equipped with:

- 1. A technically sound glider with appropriate technical documentation:
- a) Minimum recommended TBO- 50 hours.
- b) A working onboard radio with a permit from UKE or equivalent.
- 2. Parachute valid for the entire duration of the competition.
- 3. Glider pilot license and medical certificate, valid at least until 24.08.2025, and FAI Sporting License valid for the 2025 season.
- 4. Third party insurance not excluding competitions is required for each participating sailplane. Rerequired coverage must comply with EU Regulation 785/2004 which states the following limits:
 - a) MTOM < 500 kg: minimum limit SDR 750.000
 - b) 500 kg \leq MTOM < 1000 kg: minimum limit SDR 1.500.000

Gliders in 18m, Standard and CLUB A classes must be equipped with FLARM devices

We recommend to have an IGC approved GNSS recorder with pressure probe calibration. It is recommended to have a spare GNSS FR recorder.


In Juniors and Regionals, a non-certified GNSS-FR with pressure-probe altitude recording is allowed.

The competitor should have an electronic printout of the range of the FLARM device used during the competition and send it before registration to: sedzia@ostrowglide.pl

With the "switch to old view" option you can see the FLARM range in several planes - we recommend an electronic printout of this view as well. For analysis, it's best to insert 16 files at once rather than one - that's the maximum the tool allows. For analysis, it is best to use files from competitions or camps where many gliders were flown. If the competitor did not have the opportunity to make flights beforehand, it is acceptable to provide FLARM range results after the first flight made during the competition,

It is recommended to have a strobe light installed in the glider. Recommended color red or white and flash frequency between 40 and 100 per minute (according to current FAI recommendations).

Variometers with Audio function are recommended.

Additional current practice requirements (juniors only)

For pilots that have less than 500h cumulative flying hours on gliders it is necessary to perform at least 5 flights with at least 10h in cumulative duration in the year of the competition.

For pilots that have less than 25h cumulative flying hours on gliders in the previous year it is necessary to perform at least 3 flights with at least 5h in duration in the year of the the competition.

Qualification Procedures for Juniors

Pilots who are at least 25 years old in the calendar year of the championship, or younger, are eligible to participate in the competition (qualified in order):

- (a) members of SKNJ;
- (b) invited foreign pilots;
- (c) other pilots according to the order of entry fee payment.

















From the pilots who have paid the entry fee by the deadline of 13.07.2025, but did not qualify, a reserve list will be created from which, in order, pilots will be selected in case of resignation of any of the qualified pilots. If the limit of competitors in the class has not been exceeded by the deadline, pilots entered at a later date will be admitted

The order according to the date of payment of the entry fee is valid (in case of the same date, the qualification criteria in (a), (b) are applied, and after their exhaustion according to the position in the IGC ranking). If a competitor has paid the entry fee before the date of payment of the entry fee, but has not obtained qualification - the entry fee will be refunded.

Qualification Procedures - Ostrów Glide (OZS KLUB A)

1.Pilots who, no later than 1.08.2025, have made an entry in Club A class and paid the entry fee, qualify in the following order:

- a) 3rd, 4th and 5th place winners in CZS (polish all-year gliding competition) from the previous season,
- b) pilots who ranked from 8th to 20th in Polish Club A Nationals in the year preceding the competition,
- c) pilots ranked higher on the Polish Ranking List in the General Classification for the year preceding the year of the competition,
- d) if the competition was entered by pilots who are not configured on the Polish Ranking List then the order is determined according to the place on the IGC Ranking List on the date specified in paragraph 1.
- 2. After the deadline of 13.07.2025, pilots who are ranked further than 40 on the entry list shall be given the status of reserve pilots, with the order according to the eligibility criterion of para. 1

Pilots enrolled after the deadline specified in para. 1 shall be added to the reserve list in order according to the date of entry fee payment (in case of the same date, eligibility criterion c) and d) of the Regulations shall apply). The reserve pilot may replace a competitor from the qualified list who resigns from the start after the aforementioned deadline.

















3. If the limit of 40 competitors is not exceeded after the deadline of 13.07.2025, the Organizer may admit pilots entered at a later date. The order according to the date of payment of entry fee is valid (in case of the same date, the eligibility criterion c) and d) apply). The organizer may set a new limit, less than 40.

4. The organizer shall return the entry fee to the competitor, in case of his/her resignation from the start before the date specified in item. The organizer shall return the entry fee to the unqualified competitors.

Qualification Procedures - Ostrów Glide (OZS 18M)

Pilots who by the deadline (the deadline for entry determined at the beginning of the Information Bulletin) have made an application to start in a given class of competition and paid the entry fee, qualify in order according to the following criteria:

- (a) IGC ranking position as of 01.03 of the given year;
- (b) Date of entry fee payment;

A reserve list will be formed from the competitors who paid the entry fee on time but did not qualify, from which competitors will be selected in order in case of resignation of any of the qualified competitors. If the limit of competitors in a class has not been exceeded by the deadline, pilots entered at a later date will be admitted. The order in accordance with the date of payment of the entry fee applies (in the case of the same date, the above eligibility criteria apply). If competitor has paid the entry fee before the date of payment of entry fee, but has not obtained qualification – the entry fee will be returned.

Winner of previous edition of OSTRÓW GLIDE qualifies automatically

after this date, the organizer may accept the competitor's application after individual consideration.
