# SCHOOL UNIFORM Updated Apr 24

All students are required to wear school uniform whilst in school and whilst travelling to and from school. Most of the uniform is available from Stevensons, our uniform suppliers. Items marked 'St' must be purchased from Stevensons' branch in Twickenham or Stevensons online. Other items may be purchased from other high street stockists or online retailers. # **COMPULSORY UNIFORM**

- Charcoal grey skirt with dropped waist and wide pleat (no shorter than mid-thigh), charcoal grey trouser or charcoal grey Bermuda short
- Tiffin blue and white striped shirt (long and/or short sleeved)
- Tiffin blue jumper or cardigan (with Tiffin Girls' logo)
  - Black regulation school shoes, preferably leather
  - Plain, white socks (non-branded and not sports socks), 70-denier opaque black matt tights (not sheer black tights) or neutral-coloured nylon tights

## **COMPULSORY EQUIPMENT**

- Chromebook and set of headphones with microphone
- Art sketchpad (arranged by Art dept)

## **OTHER**

- Locker padlock
- Non-single use plastic water bottle or flask
- Overall for Art
- Cooking apron for 12 week food course and 2L, preferably plastic, food container (c.230 x 80 x 70mm)

# **COMPULSORY PE KIT**

Students are not permitted to wear their school jumper or other school uniform for PE.

- Tiffin branded skort and/or performance short (students must have one of these as a compulsory item but may alternate)
- St Tiffin branded performance sports leggings
- St Tiffin branded white polo t-shirt
- St Tiffin branded hockey socks
- St Tiffin branded midlayer (fleece-style top)
  - Sports trainers with laces
  - Astro boots (hockey or football rubber studs)
  - Gum shield
  - Hockey shin pads
  - House t-shirt (in house colour)
  - Sports holdall (this can be any sports bag that fits in all sports equipment and stores easily in a locker, max. size 55 x 25 x 22cm | vol 30L)
  - Pack of hair bands/ties (if hair is longer than neck-length)

# OPTIONAL PE KIT

- St Tiffin branded trackpant trouser (waterproof)
- St Tiffin branded waterproof jacket
  - Performance sports white base layer top (recommended item for autumn term)
  - Black or white sweat bands (compulsory for students with non-removable religious bands)

## INTERNAL LABELLING (NAME LABEL)

All items of uniform and PE kit should be labelled with your daughter's full name on the inside,
for example inside the neck of shirts and inside the waist of skirts. Named items which have been
lost and found can be collected from Lost Property which is run by the school office. If items are
not labelled, they are kept for a short time and then disposed of – either given to charity or the
PSA

#### **VALUABLES**

- Students are permitted to bring valuables to school but have the responsibility of looking after them
- Students who cycle to school will be asked to complete a permission form in September. Bicycles should be padlocked and stored in the bicycle racks provided

#### PERSONAL APPEARANCE

- Skirts: The purchased skirt must be worn without amendment. They are not to be rolled up. Skirts that are shorter than mid thigh must be replaced
- Plain, white socks (non-branded and not sports socks), 70-denier opaque black matt tights (not sheer black tights) or neutral-coloured nylon tights must be worn with uniform
- Shoes must be black, preferably leather, and provide support and protection for the feet. These should be in a serviceable, sensible style without coloured decorations. Heels should be wide-based and not be more that 4cm high. Open toes, sling backs, platform soles, canvas shoes, trainers/trainer-style shoes and high or narrow heels are not permitted. Boots are also not to be worn in school
- Coats can be in any colour or alternatively students can wear their school waterproof PE jackets.
   Hoodies or sweatshirts are not to be worn in place of a school coat or PE waterproof jacket.
   Leather jackets, denim jackets or faux furs are not acceptable as outdoor coats. Outdoor coats may not be worn around the school
- Jewellery worn must be discreet, such as a pair of small plain gold or silver circular stud earrings. The earrings must be a matching pair and only one earring may be worn in each ear. These must be removed for PE. No other piercings are allowed
- We recognise the diversity of our community; discreet, visible religious or cultural symbols will be individually considered on request of the parent to their daughter's Head of Year
- Permitted hair styles/cuts are inclusive of very short hair styles and natural hair and protective hair styles associated with students' ethnic and cultural identities. Student hair colour must be a naturally occurring hair colour. Braids should be in a naturally occurring hair colour
- Head coverings worn for religious reasons are permitted provided they are tied back for health
  and safety reasons. In Years 7-11 head coverings must be in school uniform colours (dark blue,
  grey or black). No other items of religious dress, including face coverings, are permitted
- Hair accessories may be any colour provided they are of a plain style and colour. Large or elaborate clips with flowers or other embellishments are not permitted, neither are scarves or bandanas tied around the head
- Make up or nail varnish must not be worn
- All students must have a fastened bag or case for books and a sports holdall. Open bags, drawstring or carrier bags are not acceptable
- A separate dress code applies for non-uniform days
