Job of the Month - Machine Learning Engineer



A Machine Learning (ML) Engineer is an IT professional who designs, builds, and maintains artificial intelligence (AI) systems that can learn and make predictions. ML engineers are a key part of data science teams, working with data scientists, data analysts, and other experts to create and deploy machine learning models.

ML engineers build large-scale systems that take in massive data sets and use them to train algorithms that can learn cognitive tasks and generate useful insights and predictions.

ML engineers are in high demand in a range of sectors, including in technology and engineering companies, in the medical profession, or within internet security.
