Summary of Clubs & Societies

In alphabetical order:

Advance Cubing Club

Open to all years. Come and join us to learn and improve the CFOP (C - cross, F - first two layers, O - orientation of the last layer and P - permutation of the last layer) method of solving a rubiks' cube. This is a bi-weekly club.

Aeronautical Origami (Paper Aeroplane Club)

Open to Years 7 to 9. Students will be taught, in a fun and educational way, about basic aeronautics (the physics of planes and how they fly). You will also construct paper aeroplanes and there will be weekly competitions.

Ancient Worlds Club

Open to all Years. Come and learn about the history, art, language and mythology of ancient societies from across the globe. We will present a new topic each week, with the opportunity to suggest or host your own sessions.

Anatomy Club

Open to Years 7 to 11. Anatomy Club will dive into the fascinating world of Human anatomy with lots of fascinating biology facts and news.

Animation Club

Open to Year 7. Students will draw, experiment with basic crafts such as wire work, explore famous artworks along with their historical techniques and backstories, all in a relaxed and creative space.

Astronomy Club

Open to all years. This club will present recent breakthroughs in the space world and showcase shocking news! Students will be presented with a new and recent astronomy breakthrough or important event each week. Students can take part in weekly kahoots to win a prize.

Beacon Christian Union

Open to all years. Come and join us for discussions about the bible, games and snacks!

Book Club

Open to Years 7 to 9. Do you love to read? If so, come and join our book club and engage in discussions about everything that we read.

Cold Cases Club

Open to Years 7 to 10. This club looks into real life cold cases, explains the main theories surrounding them. You will have the chance to make up and discuss your own theories. Prizes will be given to students with the best and funniest theories.

Crafting Club

Open to Years 7 & 8. Crafting Club will allow students to indulge in the artistic side of learning whilst having a chance to chill out after a hard week of learning.

Dance Squad

Open to Years 7 to 9. Students will have to audition for this club and attendance is then only by invitation. Dance Squad is dedicated to improving dance training in a progressive environment, where students are encouraged to learn choreography in all styles and condition their body to improve their skills.

Debate Club

Open to all years. The focus of Debate Club is to help students develop their general knowledge and confidence in public speaking, while also training them in the British Parliamentary debate format for external and internal competitions.

Drama Club

Open to Year 7. “The play’s the thing wherein we’ll catch....” the dramatic talent of our new Year 7 students! If you want to develop your drama skills whilst making new friends and having lots of fun, come along and sign up for our Club.

Economics Society

Open to Years 10 to 12. Our society offers a space for students to explore real-world markets, public policy, and global finance through student-led debates, case study competitions and policy discussions. Members will learn how economic principles shape everyday decision-making and world events. Whether you are aiming to study Economics at university or simply curious about how the world works, this Society provides opportunities to sharpen your critical thinking and analytic skills.

F1 Society

Open to all years. Are you a Formula 1 fan or would like to become one? This club will establish a community of passionate F1 fans, and students new to F1, to develop a newfound interest in the world of motorsport. Focusing on topics ranging from drivers, teams and circuits to aerodynamics that facilitate the cut-throat battles on the track.

Film Society

Open to Years 7 to 9. Film Society will teach students about the impact and history of film and analysing this. You will have a chance to develop your own screenplay or film.

First Lego League

Open to Years 7 to 9. This club will involve designing and coding robots to solve the challenges of the First Lego League Competition.

Forensic Science

Open to all years. This club will look into the exciting world of forensic science and the role of scientists in criminal investigations.

French Choir

Open to Year 9 students. Come along and practice singing in a musical ensemble in French! You will learn and memorise songs thus improving your French at the same time.

INGENIUM - Engineering/Physics Society
